The Oklahoma Ambulance Association (OKAMA) is proud to announce that our 2019 Spring Conference will be held on Thursday, May 23rd at the HistoryCenter in Oklahoma City. We will be bringing you a full slate of important sessions critical to the compliance and financial health of your organization! Our presenters are some of this industry's most respected experts on the topics.

Angie McLain, Rebecca Williamson and Asbel Montes will join forces to present a "double session" discussing the **EMS Cost Data Collection** requirements. Failure to understand these new reporting requirements could lead to significant sanctions including loss of Medicare revenue. Asbel, Rebecca and Angie will review what the new mandates will require based on current regulations, and how to best prepare yourself and your service for the phase-in.



Asbel Montes will also provide a session on the **New Payment Model** "Emergency Triage, Treat and Transport" (ET3), which will incentivize reducing costs for the emergency transport and care of Medicare fee-for-service (FFS) beneficiaries by allowing ambulance suppliers to be paid by Medicare for transport not only to emergency departments but also to alternative sites, such as urgent care centers or primary care providers.



Angie Woodward from Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics (OBN) will present information on the **Overdose Detection Mapping Application Program** (ODMAP) which provides real-time overdose surveillance data across jurisdictions to support public safety and health efforts to mobilize an immediate response to an overdose spike. It links first responders on scene to a mapping tool to track overdoses to stimulate real-time response and strategic analysis across jurisdictions. The OBN began implementing ODMAP in June 2017 and hope to receive full implementation by the end of the summer.

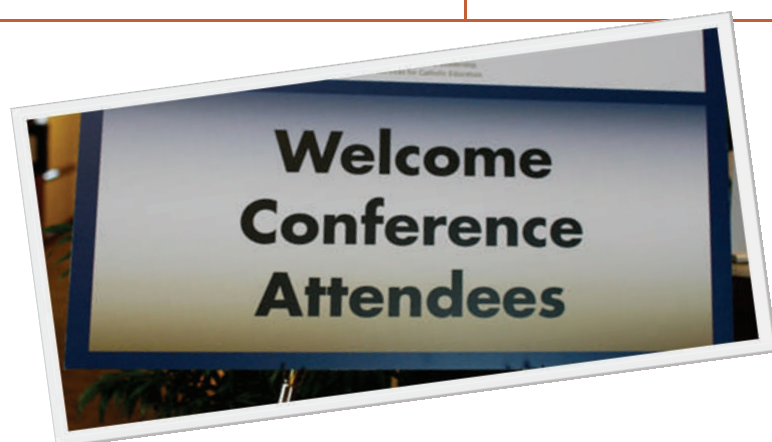
